I loosen the nut on the end of the connector and slide it back on the cable. Then pull the compression plastic piece out with a screw driver or knife backing it along the cable like you did the nut.

When you buy any new solar panel (usually over 30 Watts) it will be already fitted with two 500 - 900mm leads with MC4 connectors attached for you to get the power safely out of the solar panel.
