During 1990-2020, total GHG emissions in the Republic of Moldova decreased by approximately 69.8%, up to 13,662 Mt CO2 equivalent, as a result of the economic crisis.

In April 2024, the Moldovan Parliament passed a groundbreaking climate action law, committing the country to achieving net-zero emissions by 2050. This represents the most ...

As part of its EU integration, Moldova is preparing to implement a carbon pricing framework, which can generate public revenue and promote decarbonization by incentivizing emission reductions.
