NEVER use a generator inside homes, garages, crawlspaces, sheds, or similar areas, even when using fans or opening doors and windows for ventilation. Deadly levels of carbon monoxide can quickly ...

Learn to recognize the symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning: headache, nausea, dizziness, shortness of breath, weakness and fainting.

Never run generators indoors, including garages, basements, crawlspaces and sheds. Get to fresh air right away if you start to feel dizzy or weak.
